 - (2) This camp is free to the players, no registration required
 - (3) Land O Frost update – there were 31 teams last season of which \$100 per teams brought \$3100 in club sponsorship
 - (4) Small sided teams – the club is considering purchasing uniforms in place of the t-shirts from previous seasons. The teams would be required to wear them, and also return them at the end of the season.
 - (5) Roughly \$20 per player in club cost, with a replenishment rate of 10-15% each season.
